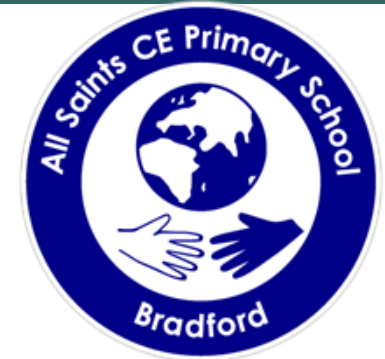

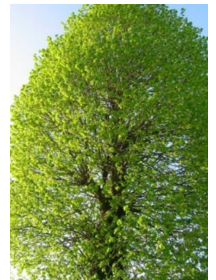

This term in Year 4 we
are learning about...

Literacy

In Literacy we will be focusing on myths and legends and information leaflets.

The children will learn how to use headings and subheadings effectively. Furthermore they will show how information can be presented in a variety of ways. Children will develop their writing skills focusing on individual targets from the result of their ongoing assessments.

During individual reading children will work on developing their own specific reading skills, including some having additional phonics practice. In addition, the children will begin to look at answering literal questions. This will involve children learning to find key words, clues or pieces of information to help answer the question given.

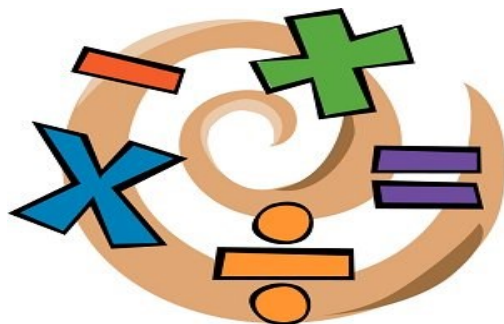

Maths

During Autumn there will be a strong focus on calculating and counting and understanding number. Children will revisit place value. They will then begin to develop their abilities at using written methods for the four different types of operations; addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. Children will progress onto using and applying the four operations to solve everyday problems including interpreting data and finding the perimeter and area of shapes.

Topic



In **SCIENCE** the children will focus on sound and how we are able to hear things. The children will explore how sounds are made and how they travel. We will also be looking at animals including humans. During this, the children will focus on classifying animals and will explore different habitats that animals live in.

In **RE** we will focus on the big question "Is it right to steal?" and what different religions teach. Due to performing 'Wicked' at My BD5 Literacy festival, we will also look at issues linked to equality and acceptance.

Art and **DT** will be linked directly to the topic as part of our creative curriculum. The children will be creating Saxon houses, considering the use of natural resources. Furthermore they will create jewellery, write in runes and design Viking long ships.
