Teaching Your Child to Match Colours

1. Put some household objects of four different colours into a bag and ask your child to pick them out one at a time and match onto the correct coloured plate.
2. Use ice cube trays or muffin trays and put coloured stickers or paper in the wells. Sort coloured pom poms, bottle tops, pegs, buttons, paper clips or anything you can lay your hands on!
3. Make a giant 'pom pom drop' using painted cardboard tubes.
4. Sort crayons into coloured tin cans.
5. Match coloured pegs onto a coloured card wheel, or use paint colour charts from your local DIY store.
