**During Spring Term in Year
1, we are learning about...**

English

In writing we will be studying a range of fiction and non-fiction writing genres this term; these will include fact files, character descriptions and recounts.

We will continue to focus on using capital letters and full stops. In addition we will look at question marks and extending sentences by using 'and'.

Reading/Phonics

We will continue to use the Little Wandle and will be looking at Phase 5 sounds. Catch up groups are already being done to help children practice other sounds.

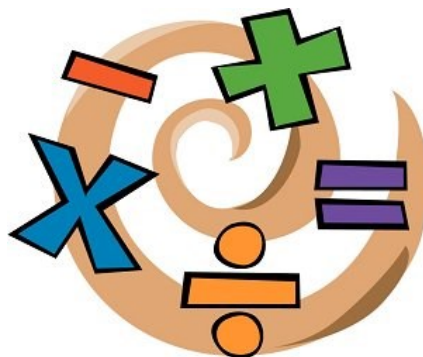
We will send homework home for the sounds children will learn the week after. Please practice these sounds and upload a video on Class Dojo.

In reading comprehension, children will continue to work on their prediction skills and make predictions on what might happen on the basis of what has been read so far. They will work more independently for retrieval reading skill. Retrieval is a reading skill where children have to pick out information from a text in order to answer questions about it.

Finally, children will continue to have reading sessions in an afternoon linked to their current phases.

Maths

The children will look at subtraction of numbers to 20 and subtract one-digit and 2-digit numbers. They will look at groups of a number and arrays to begin to understand multiplying. After they will look at fractions and identify what a half and a quarter are. Finally, they will learn about different coins and notes. Please practice writing numbers at home and counting in 2,s, 5,s and 10,s. Also, help children to tell time and know the days of the week.



Science

In science children will learn about Animals including humans—Why animals are different. They will also continue to explore the seasons and the changes in them. Finally, they will identify different types of plants and their parts.
