**During Autumn Term in
Year 2, we are learning
about...**

English

In writing we will be studying a range of fiction and non-fiction writing genres this term; these will include story recounts, letter writing, instructions and character descriptions. Children will learn the following writing techniques including:

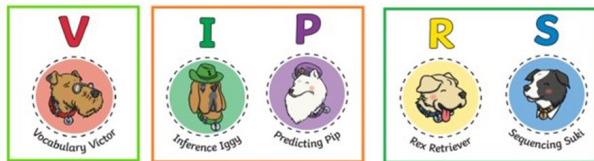
Subordinating conjunctions, expanded noun phrases and commas in a list. Furthermore, they will learn the features of a non-fiction text such as headings and subheadings.

Children will develop their writing skills focusing on individual targets from the result of their ongoing assessments.

Reading/Phonics

During individual reading children will work on developing their own specific reading skills, including some having additional phonics practice. In addition, the children will

continue to practice SATs style questions. The reading skills children will be focusing on inference, retrieval, vocabulary, prediction and sequencing.

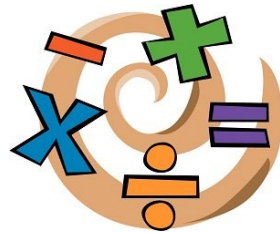


Children will have the opportunity to develop their speaking and listening (oracy) skills. Furthermore children will be exposed to new higher level vocabulary.

Maths

Children will be working on multiplication and division. Then move onto learning about money, time and shape. Children will also learn to read and interpret different forms of data (bar, tally and pictogram). After children will move onto learning to recognise, find, name and write fractions $\frac{1}{3}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{2}{4}$ and $\frac{3}{4}$ of a length, shape, set of objects or quantity. Children will also write simple fractions for example, $\frac{1}{2}$ of 6 = 3 and recognise the equivalence of $\frac{2}{4}$ and $\frac{1}{2}$.

Please support your children in continuously learning their 2-, 5- and 10-times tables.
