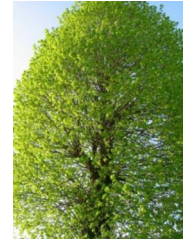

**During Autumn Term in
Year 4, we are learning
about...**

Literacy

In Literacy we will be focusing on writing a Character description. The children will learn how to writing techniques including: **fronted adverbials, sentence openers, expanded noun phrases, tenses and paragraphs**. We will have a focus on enhancing our vocabulary. Children will develop their writing skills focusing on individual targets from the result of their ongoing assessments.

During individual reading children will work on developing their own specific reading skills, including some having additional phonics practice. In addition, we will focus on retrieval, comprehension, inference questions as well as finding the meaning of words in context. Children will explore how they can use a dictionary to find the meaning of unfamiliar words and how to use the thesaurus to find synonyms.

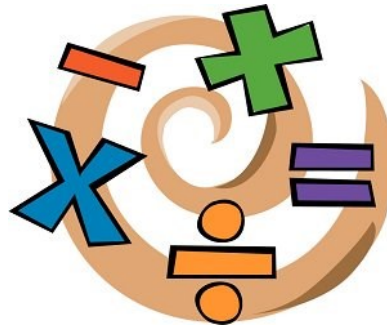

Maths

Children will revisit the four operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division) and other areas of the year 4 curriculum. Children will progress onto using and applying this knowledge to solve everyday problems. Some examples in the year 4 curriculum include rounding four digit numbers, inverse calculations, area, perimeter, time, decimals and fractions.

Children will have a national test on the 1-12 times tables. Please ensure children in year 4 are regularly practicing their times tables. They may use application such as TT Rockstars to help them.



Science- the children will focus on 'Animals including humans'. The children will explore the importance of having a healthy diet, healthy teeth, food chains and classification of animals.

History- How did the Anglo-Saxon settlements change Britain?

Geography will be linked directly to the topic as part of our creative curriculum. Most of year 4 will be experiencing a night away in Whitby at the Youth hostel. We will be learning about coastal features and land use. On our return to school, we will be sharing what we have learned with the rest of the year group and will be studying the similarities and differences between Bradford and Whitby, using maps and photographs.
